## An Introduction to The Wiltshire Centre

### **About Us**

Our Club is a section of the Caravan And Motorhome Club of Great Britain. Our Patron is His Royal Highness Prince Philip. The Club itself is a large organisation and has 900 staff and an annual turnover of in excess of £100 million pounds.

The organisation has in excess of 800,000 members across the country. Our Centre alone has circa 700 members.

'The Club' operates a number of Commercial sites across the UK and administers over 2500 certified locations sites (limited to 5 caravans)

### **Our Aim**

As a Centre our objective is to provide caravanning opportunities (Rallies) for our members throughout the year at locations across our region, across the country and abroad.

### **So - What is a Rally?**

Firstly what a rally isn't. It is not some sort of mad speed trial for cars with caravans attached chasing around the countryside at breakneck speeds doing handbrake turns and power slides. Leave all that to the car rally drivers!!

In reality it is a gathering of Caravan and Motorhome Club Members of all ages and backgrounds who enjoy weekends away with fun and fellowship thrown in for good measure. We use our caravans / motor homes all year round in lovely surroundings.

### **Who goes on rallies?**

It's a complete mix of people ranging from families with young children, families with teenagers, people without children, people whose children are grown up, retired people, people on their own, but all with the common aim of meeting like-minded people and enjoying themselves. One thing all these people have in common is enjoying the freedom offered by caravanning.

### **Where are rallies held?**

The Wiltshire Centre of the Caravan and Motorhome Club holds rallies throughout the year (yes, even during the winter) at a variety of venues throughout Wiltshire and the surrounding counties.

Many rallies are held in quiet fields. Others are held at locations close to a local attraction or event (such as Longleat or Frome Agricultural and Cheese Show). A few rallies are held at commercial sites such as Hoburne Bashley, Pentewan Sands in Cornwall and Green Hill Farm C & C Park at Landford in the New Forest. During the winter months, the rallies are usually held on hard-standing in school playgrounds (no getting bogged down in the mud!).

**What happens on a rally?**

Lots! Generally, the day time is available to spend at our leisure although sometimes optional activities are arranged (such as fishing, walks, treasure hunts).

**What facilities are required?**

A fresh water tap on the rally field, and an elsan waste disposal point. (Access to a main drainage manhole or a suitable pit)

Modern caravans and motorhomes are perfectly suited to running entirely with bottled gas and a 12V leisure battery.
